  - 7b) What did Hannah do when the child was 12 years old? *1 Sam. 1:24-28; 1 Sam. 2:18-19*
- 8) 8a) What did Hannah do each year for her son at the yearly sacrifice? *1 Sam. 2:18-19*
  - 8b) The LORD is very gracious to those that serve HIM. How did He additionally bless Hannah?  
*1 Sam. 2:20-21; Psa. 18:1-3; Psa. 28:1-2; Psa. 62:1-2*
- 9) In 1 Samuel 2:1-10 we have Hannah’s prayer, or in some translations it is called “her song.” When did this occur, and was it also prophetic? *Note different translations*
