- 5) Verse 17: Who shall “lie down and not rise” *R2338; 1951; 2462*

- 6) What “new thing” is meant in verse 19? Explain “rivers in the desert.” *R1379; 1380*

- 7) Who are they that shall show God’s praise in Isaiah 43:21?
